Rembrandt Light









There should be a triangle of light on the cheek opposite the source.

Split Light











There should be a strong highlight side and a strong shadow side on the face.

Broad Light









There should be be a small triangle of light on the cheek opposite the light, which is angled away from the source.

Butterfly Light







*elevated on a small boom, angled down



There should be a shadow underneath the nose, with slight shadows on the cheeks and chin.

Loop Light







elevated on a small boom, angled down



Compared to Rembrandt, the light is elevated and angled down. There's a small loop shadow on the cheeks and under the nose.
